<p>SATURDAY Welcome and initial day January 14th 2023</p>	<p>In the morning we had breakfast in the hotel. After the breakfast we went to the school by bus. When we arrived to the school we had a welcoming presentation where we learned a few things about the Lithuania and Kaunas. Then we split up into the assigned groups and went to work on everything that needed to be accomplished during this meeting. On the presentation of results, we discussed about what has been done since the last meeting in Ireland and what are the things that we should accomplish during our stay in Kaunas.</p> <p>Front end group gave us the QR code to the yet unfinished web site with webcams from every country and it also shows which country is connected to the website and which is not. The next task would be to connect Norway and Lithuania and also to work on the webcam connection to the server.</p> <p>The electronics group told us that it does not matter if we use a four pin or a six-pin configuration since the wagons from different countries won't be connected together. The type of the connector also does not matter.</p> <p>The mechanics group showed us a 3d model of the showcase for all the wagons. It is a 10-sided shape with a webcam in the middle. To record everything, the webcam would be rotated around with a stepper motor.</p> <p>The photo and video group took pictures and videos through the project and said that they will post them so if the project book, web page or the social media group needs them they can easily access them. For now, there are enough pictures and videos from all the previous meetings and they are still collecting them now in Lithuania.</p> <p>The Project Book group decided that they would design a magazine like project book at the cost of around 15 euros. It would be printed in one of the schools. The project book would also need to be both printed and in PDF format.</p> <p>Public relations group waits for the photos and videos to get uploaded so they can upload it online. As a form of connection with public, the pictures will be uploaded to the Instagram account of the project.</p> <p>The project web group is working on the project website and is waiting for the photos and videos group to send them the material for the website. Their future task is to just continue working on the website by posting and writhing the content produced from the other groups.</p> <p>Teaching materials group wants to split the teaching materials into two parts, the technical part and the cultural part. They will write about how the project was done step by step so other people can see it all while keeping the teaching material as simple as possible for the technical part, and for the cultural part they will write about the culture and the interesting facts about the counties they have visited during this project.</p>
