<p>HARD WORKING DAY Sunday 15th January 2023</p>	
<p>10:00</p>	<p>Good Morning – Welcome to Kaunas Flashlight involved a recap of what was decided on Saturday.</p> <p>A change to the printed agenda at the request of the students to include a period of practical time to develop the projects further in Workline A.</p> <p>Irish and Croatian delegations worked together to connect the ESP32s in their projects. The Croatians having a particular skills set were willing and able to share their practical skills and knowledge. While the remaining delegations worked on their own projects, the Italians prepared the area and assembled their train wagons and website for demonstration.</p>
<p>12:00</p>	<p>All countries presented the existing wagons they had constructed. There was no delegation with all carriages completed and that was probably to be expected, given the complex technical nature of the project. Some delegations were able to demonstrate that they could program each wagon to operate the animations. Other delegations had some carriages still in the workshop as soldering was being done.</p>
<p>14:00</p>	<p>Proposals were made for the project logo. There were 11 proposals at first in which all member nations submitted at least one proposal. The first vote on proposals aimed to reduce the number of proposals down to three possible options.</p>
