15:00	We visited the Kaunas Ninth Fort Museum. This was a military fort built between 1903-1913. This was excellent trip that detailed the forts engineer construction such as an inner and outer cavity wall for defensive purpose, the outer wall and the sand within the cavity acting as a shock absorber from cannon blasts. The fort was built by the Russian Empire, and was used in both world wars and was used as a concentration camp by the Nazi's in the second world war.
